



The Ripple Effects of the NDIS: Two Years On

Two years ago CDNet facilitated a forum to gain an understanding of the progression towards the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) from various perspectives. Now, two years on, this forum will explore the impacts and ripple effects of the implementation of the NDIS in the ACT and what that might mean for the future.

This whole day forum will provide the opportunity to hear from and engage with the experiences of participants, carers, community service organisations and the NDIA around the transition over the past two years both within the disability space but also the ripple effects into other fields such as aged care and home and community care.
