What is Results Based Accountability[™]?

“RBA is a disciplined way of thinking and taking action that communities can use to improve the lives of children, families and the community as a whole” (RBA Training workbook 2009).

RBA starts with ends and works backward, step by step, to means.

The ends are conditions of well-being for families and communities eg ‘residents with good jobs’ or ‘children ready for school’ or ‘public places without graffiti’

The ends for programs are how are they better off eg ‘what percentage of people are in job training programs’

RBA gets you from talk to action quicker, uses plain language and common sense methods.
