The Community Development Network (CDNet) has been providing support and information to the community sector in the ACT and surrounding areas since 2003. The email list is currently distributed to over **2500** members.

What is CDNet? CDNet is a network of people from community, non-government and government organisations interested in community development (CD) events, programs, principles, and practices. It is funded by the ACT Government's Community Services Directorate through the ACT Council of Social Services.

A primary aim of CDNet is to facilitate sharing information on activities relevant to community development through the CDNet email distribution list and Facebook group. Opportunities for discussion and learning are provided through CDNet Community of Practice (CDCOP) workshops.
